Follow I-25 S, CO-115 S and US-50 W to Elm Ave in Lincoln Park

1 h 3 min (54.2 mi)

- ↑ 1. Head north on I-25 N 0.9 mi
- ↘ 2. Use the right 2 lanes to take exit 148 for Rockrimmon Blvd toward Corporate Dr/Neveda Ave 0.5 mi
- ↶ 3. Turn left onto S Rockrimmon Blvd 272 ft
- ↶ 4. Turn left to merge onto I-25 S 7.1 mi
 Parts of this road may be closed at certain times or days
- ↘ 5. Use the 2nd from the right lane to take exit 140 for Tejon St toward CO-115 S/Nevada Ave 0.3 mi
- ↶ 6. Use the 2nd from the right lane to keep left at the fork and follow signs for Tejon Street 0.1 mi
- ↘ 7. Turn right onto CO-115 S/US-85 S/US-87 S/S Nevada Ave 1.0 mi
- ↑ 8. Continue onto CO-115 S/S Nevada Ave 0.8 mi
- ↶ 9. Keep left to stay on CO-115 S 28.5 mi
- ↑ 10. Continue straight to stay on CO-115 S 2.7 mi
- ↘ 11. Turn right to merge onto US-50 W toward Canon City/Royal Gorge 11.0 mi
- ↶ 12. Turn left onto S 9th St 1.2 mi

Take Oak Creek Grade Rd and Forge Rd to Savage Loop in Cañon City

5 min (2.2 mi)

- 📍 13. At the traffic circle, take the 1st exit onto Elm Ave 0.3 mi
- ↶ 14. Turn left onto Oak Creek Grade Rd 0.5 mi
- ↘ 15. Turn right onto Forge Rd 1.1 mi
- ↶ 16. Turn left onto Fenris Blvd 328 ft
- ↶ 17. Turn left onto Savage Loop 0.3 mi
 Destination will be on the right
