I had a call earlier this month from an old friend of ours, Tom Abbott. He is no longer involved with orchids but has morphed to growing hemp. Not marijuana, hemp. Tested to be very low in THC. 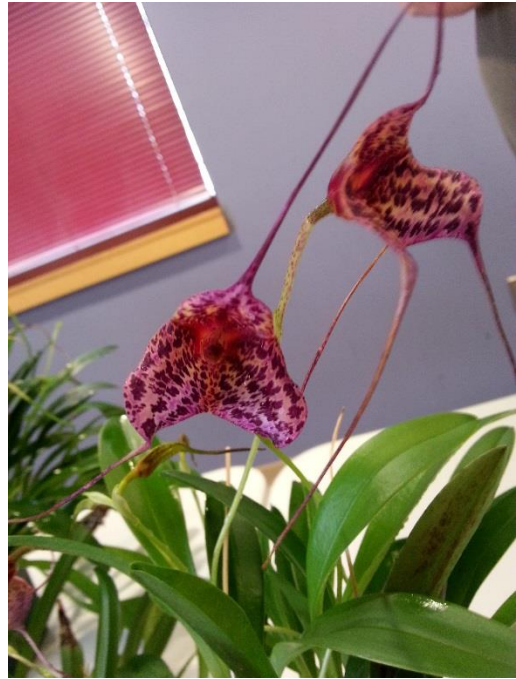

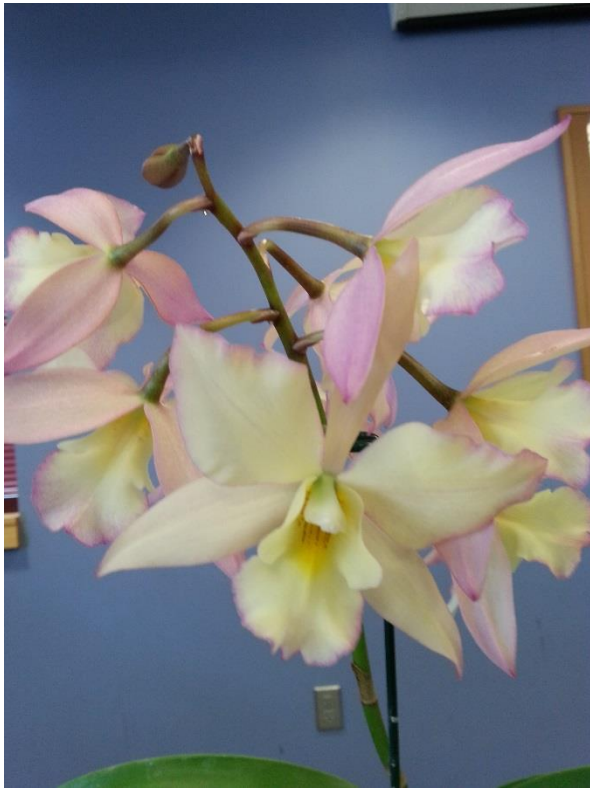

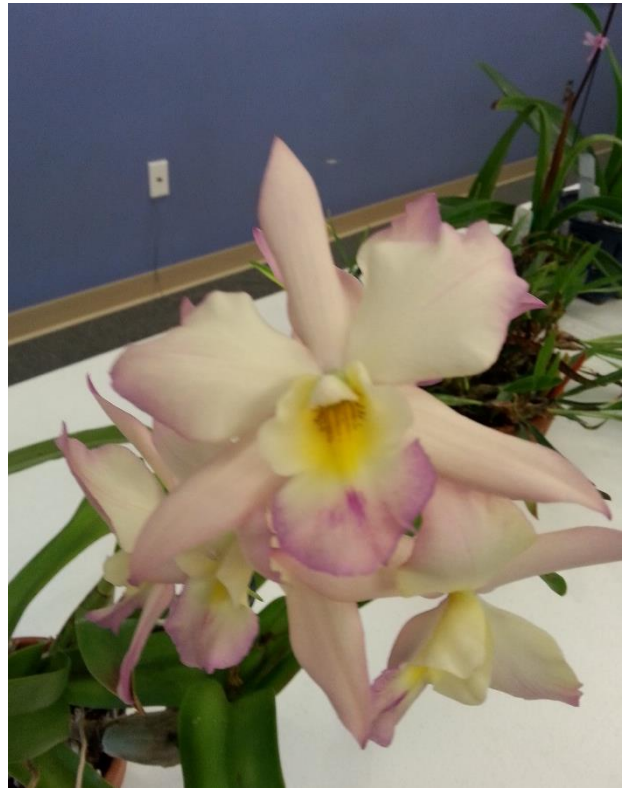

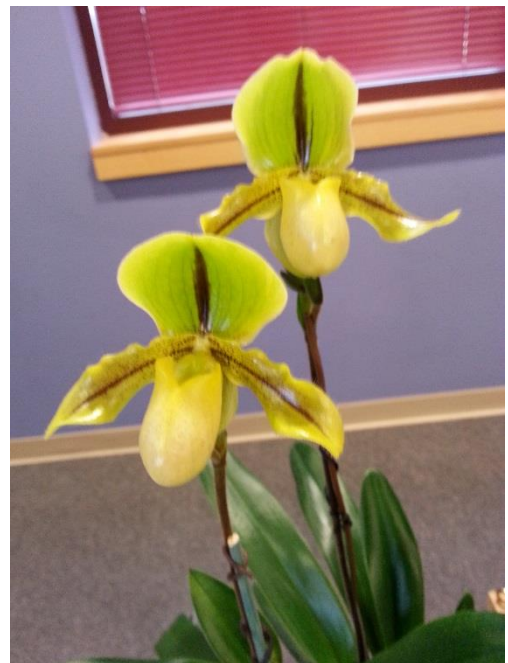
